

ArtsVote in Hawai'i

(Updated as of 7/17/22)

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

CONFIRM

Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022
- Be a resident of Hawai'i
- Not be currently incarcerated for a felony conviction
- Not be adjudicated "non compos mentis" (mentally incompetent)

STEP 1

Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u> by <u>Election Day</u>, <u>November 8</u>, <u>2022</u>, <u>in-person</u> at a Voter Service Center by <u>Election Day</u>, or <u>by mail</u> by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 31</u>, <u>2022</u>. If registering by mail, your registration must be RECEIVED by your <u>County Elections Division</u> before <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 31</u>, <u>2022</u>. After this, you can register to vote in person at a <u>Voter Service Center</u> beginning <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 25</u>, <u>2022</u> through <u>Election Day</u>, <u>November 8</u>, <u>2022</u>, excluding Sundays. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 20</u>, <u>2022</u>.</u>

Receive Your Mail Ballot

Cast Your Vote

In Hawai'i, all pre-registered voters will receive their <u>Mail Ballots</u> by **Friday, October 21, 2022**, so it is imperative that your registration information, especially your address, is up-to-date before this deadline. *Don't delay, pledge to confirm your pre-registered voter status by Tuesday, October 4, 2022.*

MAIL BALLOT: Cast your vote by mailing-in your COMPLETED and SIGNED Mail Ballot which must be RECEIVED by your <u>County Elections Division</u> by <u>Election Day</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 8</u>, <u>2022</u> by <u>7:00pm</u>. Officials recommend mailing your absentee Mail Ballot by <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 21</u>, <u>2022</u>. You may also HAND-DELIVER your absentee Mail Ballot inperson at a <u>Voter Service Center or to a Ballot Drop Box Place of Deposit</u>. Your ballot must be secured in the secrecy envelope and SIGNED on the OUTER return envelope. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to mail in your absentee Mail Ballot early by Tuesday</u>, <u>October 18</u>, <u>2022</u>.

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: Cast your vote early in-person at your local <u>Voter Service</u>

<u>Center</u>. Voter Service Centers (check your <u>County Elections Division</u> for details on dates and hours of operation) begin opening as early as <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 25</u>, <u>2022</u> through <u>Election Day</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 8</u>, <u>2022</u>, excluding Sundays. If you choose to vote in-person on <u>Election Day</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 8</u>, <u>2022</u>, polling hours take place between <u>7:00am</u> until <u>7:00pm</u> at your local <u>Voter Service Center</u>. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to cast your vote in-person during Early Voting and avoid the Election Day crowds</u>.

STEP 4 Celebrate Your Vote
