

ArtsVote in Idaho

(Updated as of 7/17/22)

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

CONFIRM

Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022
- Be a resident of Idaho for 30 days before the election
- Not be a convicted felon, unless your civil rights have been restored
- Not be currently confined in prison on conviction of a criminal offense

STEP 1

Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u> by midnight, <u>in-person</u> by **5:00 PM**, or POSTMARKED <u>by mail</u> by **Friday**, **October 14**, **2022**. (NOTE: You must re-register to vote if you have not voted within the last four years.) If you are a first-time voter, you must include a copy of your current and valid photo ID and a copy of your current utility bill, bank statement, or government document that shows your name and address. If you miss the registration deadline, you can only register to vote in-person at your <u>Voting/Polling Location</u> on **Election Day**, **November 8**, **2022**. *Don't delay*, *pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Tuesday*, *September 20*, *2022*.

STEP 2

Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred) In Idaho, voting by <u>Absentee Ballot</u> does not require an excuse, but you must apply for it because it will not be sent to you automatically. You must apply for an <u>Absentee Ballot online</u>, <u>by mail</u>, or <u>in-person</u> by <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 28</u>, <u>2022</u> at <u>5:00 PM</u>; otherwise, you will have to physically vote in person. You must have an Idaho Driver's License or State Identification Card, and the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number to complete the online Absentee Ballot request. *Don't delay, pledge to request your Absentee Ballot by Tuesday, October 4, 2022*.

STEP 3 Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOT: Cast your vote by returning your COMPLETED and SIGNED Absentee Ballot by mail or in-person, so that it is RECEIVED by your County Clerk by Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022 by 8:00pm. Don't delay, pledge to mail in your Absentee Ballot by Tuesday, October 18, 2022.

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: Cast your vote early in-person at your correct Voting/Polling
Location. Early Voting begins Monday, October 24, 2022 through Friday, November 4, 2022 at 5:00pm. Early Voting locations and their hours vary by county, so contact your County Clerk for more information. If you choose to vote in-person on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022, polling hours take place between 8:00am to 8:00pm at your correct Voting/Polling Location. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote in-person during Early Voting and avoid the Election Day crowds.

STEP 4Celebrate Your Vote
