

### ArtsVote in Nevada

(Updated as of 7/17/22)

#### Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

#### **CONFIRM**

**Pre-Requisites** 

- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Be 18 years of age or older (you may pre-register at 17 years old)
- Be a resident of Nevada for 30 days before an election and have continuously lived in your precinct 10 days before the election.
- Not declared by a court to be mentally incompetent.
- Not convicted of a felony or have had your civil rights restored.

#### STEP 1

Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u> or <u>by mail</u>. ONLINE registrations are due by Thursday, November 3, 2022. All MAILED registration applications must be POSTMARKED by Tuesday, October 11, 2022. If you cannot meet either of these pre-registration deadlines, you can only register to vote in-person at <u>your polling place</u> on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by September 20, 2022.

#### STEP 2

Receive Your Mail-In Ballot You do not have to request a ballot. Nevada is a universal vote by mail state, which means all pre-registered voters will **automatically** receive a ballot by mail in October. If you don't receive a ballot by mail automatically, it means there is an error in your current registration that you <u>need to fix</u>. Be proactive, double check the accuracy of your voter registration by September 20, 2022 before ballots are mailed out.

## STEP 3 Cast Your Vote

MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOTS: All mail-in ballots must be POSTMARKED by Election Day in order to be counted. If you prefer to hand-deliver your completed ballot, it must be RECEIVED by 7:00pm on Election Day to your polling place. Otherwise, you have to physically vote in-person on Election Day. You can sign up to track your mail-in ballot on Nevada's Secretary of State website. Don't delay, pledge to mail-in your completed ballot by Tuesday, October 18, 2022.

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: Early Voting in Nevada begins on Saturday, October 22, 2022 through Friday, November 4, 2022. Days and hours of operation vary by county. A list of early voting polling places by county can be found <a href="here">here</a>. If voting on Election Day, polling locations open at 7:00am on Election Day and remain open until 7:00pm. As long as you are in line by 7:00pm, you will be allowed to vote. A list of Election Day polling places by county can be found <a href="here">here</a>. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote in-person the morning of Election Day, November 8, 2022.

# STEP 4 Celebrate Your Vote
