

### **ArtsVote in Ohio**

(Updated as of 7/17/22)



Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2022

#### **CONFIRM**

**Pre-Requisites** 

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election
- Be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before the election
- Not incarcerated for a felony conviction under the laws of this state, another state, or the United States
- Not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court
- Not been permanently disenfranchised for violating the election laws

#### STEP 1

Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u>, <u>in-person</u>, or <u>by mail</u>. Voter registration forms must be either RECEIVED by your <u>county board of elections</u> or SUBMITTED online by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 11</u>, 2022. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Tuesday</u>, <u>September 20</u>, 2022.

#### STEP 2

Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred) In Ohio, <u>voting by absentee</u> ballot **does not require an excuse**, but you must <u>apply</u>. <u>for it</u> because it will not be sent to you automatically. There are 3 ways to request your absentee ballot: 1) Print your request form and <u>mail it to your county board of elections</u>, 2) Call and request an application be mailed to you by your <u>county board of elections</u>, 3) <u>Write a letter to request</u> an application and mail it in. You can begin requesting an absentee ballot application on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 12</u>, <u>2022</u> and the completed application must be RECEIVED by <u>Noon on Saturday</u>, <u>November 5</u>, <u>2022</u>. <u>If you prefer to vote by absentee ballot</u>, <u>pledge to submit your absentee ballot</u> <u>application by Tuesday</u>, <u>October 4</u>, <u>2022</u>.

## STEP 3 Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: In Ohio, completed mail-in absentee ballots must be POSTMARKED to the <u>county board of elections</u> by Monday, November 7, 2022 in order to be counted. Alternatively, you can HAND-DELIVER your absentee ballot inperson to your <u>county board of elections</u> on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at 7:30pm. You can sign up to <u>track your absentee ballot</u> on the Ohio Board of Elections website. (NOTE: Absentee ballots are the first votes counted on Election Night.) Don't delay, pledge to mail-in your completed absentee ballot by Oct. 18, 2022.

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: You may vote early in Ohio at specific <a href="Early Voting sites">Early Voting sites</a>
beginning as early as Wednesday, October 12, 2022 through Monday, November 7, 2022 (times vary, check your <a href="Local county board of elections">Local county board of elections</a>). If <a href="Voting on Election">Voting on Election</a> on the Ohio Board of Elections website. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. <a href="Don't delay">Don't delay</a>, <a href="pleage to cast your vote during Early Voting and avoid the crowds">Local County States</a>
